### How to use a social story:

- When your child is in a happy mood, review the social story at least 3-5 times the week before the visit. If your child becomes upset, take a break and try again later.
- Talk positively about the clinic, doctors and medical staff.
- It's suggested to bring your social story with you the day of your visit to assist with transition and create a sense of familiarity.

### I am going to the Children's Specialty Clinic so that my family can make sure that I am healthy.





# My parents sign us in at the registration desk.







Then we go to the waiting area. I can sit or play or read. There are fun things to play with. I can bring some of my own things from home, too. Some things I would want to bring are:





When my name is called, I go into the clinic area. My parents will go with me. First, I get weighed. I take off my shoes, and then I stand on the scale. I hold still.





I keep my shoes off and stand against the wall. A ruler slides down just above my head to see how tall I am. I stand up very straight and still. It does not hurt.





I go into the room with the doctor. There may be a tall table for me to sit on. There is a computer that is only used by the doctors and nurses.





The doctor or nurse comes in to talk with my parents about me. I can listen to them or play with a toy. The doctor or nurse may ask me questions. I will try to answer them.





I get my blood pressure checked. A cuff is placed around my arm. It feels like a tight squeeze for just a little bit. I watch the numbers or listen to the machine beep until the squeeze is over. I hold still so it goes quicker.





Next, I will get my temperature checked. A thermometer is placed in my ear or over my forehead. I will hold still until someone says I am all done.







## The doctor will use a small light to look at my eyes and nose.





### Then, the doctor uses a small flashlight to look inside my ears and mouth. I hold my body still. I open my mouth real big so they can see inside.





After that, the doctor will listen to my heart with a stethoscope. I may be asked to take a deep breath in and out. I can ask them to wait anytime if I need a break.





### Then, I will lay flat on my back on the exam table. The doctor will gently feel my belly with their hands.





### When I am finished with the doctor, my parents will set up my next appointment. I am all done for today!
