- Participate in continuing education, quality improvement initiatives, and contribute to a family-centered clinic environment.

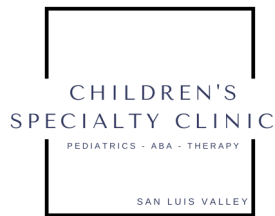
